

Video 1 Discussion Guide & Activity Instructions

ACTIVITY INSTRUCTIONS:

It took Leonardo Da Vinci several years to create The Mona Lisa, his masterpiece! Today, students can choose to either recreate the actual Mona Lisa OR Jason's attempt at the Mona Lisa. Make sure everyone has a "Mona Lisa" activity sheet and access to enough markers/crayons/pencils. Set a timer on your phone for 3 minutes (or for however long you'd like this activity to take) and then say GO! You can pick a few to showcase at the end if you have time before jumping into discussion question #1.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

- 1) **Your Masterpiece:** Would you consider your drawing a masterpiece? If you actually spent years painting a masterpiece, what do you think you would paint? (A person, animal, a place?)
- 2) **God's Masterpiece:** Jason said we are all God's masterpiece. What do you think that means? (Help students realize how important it is to go through life knowing that we are God's masterpiece and so is everyone else; those we can see and those that live on the other side of the world.)
- 3) **Caring For Others:** If everyone is God's masterpiece, how should we treat them? (Help students understand that God created each of us on purpose, with love. Their parents, siblings, friends, kids that annoy them, and kids on the other side of the world.)
- 4) **Far From Home:** Have you ever thought about other kids your age who live far away from here in places like Africa or Asia? What do you think are some of the biggest differences are for someone who lives in Africa or Asia and someone who lives here? (You might need to start out by sharing what the furthest place you have personally been and asking the same questions to a few others. The point of this is just to get them thinking about how different it would be)
